



**INVITATION TO COMMENT ON THE CONSULTATION PAPER ON NERSA
REDETERMINATION OF ESKOM'S SIXTH MULTI-YEAR PRICE DETERMINATION
(MYPD6) REGULATED ASSET BASE (RAB) FOR THE GENERATION BUSINESS FOR
YEAR 1 (2025/26), YEAR 2 (2026/27) AND YEAR 3 (2027/28)**

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the Electricity, Piped-Gas and Petroleum Pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006) as amended, Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

NERSA received a Court Judgment on the **21 December 2025**. The Court Judgment ordered that NERSA should re-determine the value of the Eskom RAB and the allowable revenue due to ESKOM in respect of depreciation and then adjust the allowable revenue and Eskom average tariff for the 2026/2027 and 2027/2028 tariff years accordingly after undertaking a stakeholder consultation process. The Court Judgment stipulates a closing date for consultation to be the 21 January 2026.
